General

Persons who operate a vehicle on the CWI campus are responsible for knowing and complying with these regulations. The college assumes no liability for loss or damage to a vehicle or its contents.

Handicap Parking

Only students, faculty, staff and visitors with handicapped license plates or placards from a government agency may park in designated handicapped spaces.

Warning Tickets and Towing

CWI Warning Tickets have no fee or fine attached to them. They are used as a communication and tracking system for offending vehicles. Repeated ticket violations can be forwarded to Student Affairs/Human Resources for appropriate action and could be towed at the owner's expense.

Vehicles may receive warning tickets or be towed for:

- Parked on walkway or grass area.
- Blocking or obstructing traffic lanes, service areas, posted areas, hydrants.
- Parking over lines or in two spaces.
- Over 20 minutes in a loading dock/zone.
- Reserved space (unauthorized).
- Handicapped space (unauthorized).
- Posted fire lane.
- Creating a safety hazard.
- Unauthorized vehicles parking in CWI parking lots.
- Overnight parking.
- Camping in CWI parking lots.
- Any area not designated as a parking space should be considered a no parking zone.
- Parking that impedes progress of necessary maintenance projects (snow removal, paving, etc.).

Abandoned Vehicles

After 72 hours, ticketed vehicles determined to be abandoned may be towed at owner's expense and locked in impound by the contracted tow company. Owners must provide proof of registration and insurance to release the car and are responsible for storage fees.

Inoperable Vehicles

If a vehicle is left on property and is inoperable, please notify CWI Security at (208) 562-3333 or security@cw.edu. CWI Security will work with the individual for removal of the vehicle. If the vehicle is not removed in the time frame discussed, the vehicle will be considered abandoned. Repairs of an inoperable vehicle cannot occur in our parking areas due to liability reasons.

If the vehicle impedes projects or events that are planned, CWI reserves the right to move the vehicle to an alternative location or to tow the vehicle off property.

Overnight/Long Term Parking

According to CWI's Operations Policy, campus property exists to serve primarily the educational mission of the College. Activities occurring on campus property must be an appropriate use of that space at all times.

In order to maintain adequate parking space in campus parking lots for authorized individuals, unauthorized vehicles will be ticketed and face possible physical removal. Therefore, when the need arises for you to park your car in a CWI parking lot overnight or for an extended period on authorized college business, please notify Campus Security at security@cw.edu. In the email give your name, location of the vehicle, make, model, and color of the vehicle as well as the license plate number. This action will ensure that CWI security personnel can identify your vehicle as being authorized for overnight/long term parking.
