Welcome to the CWI Workforce Development Nursing Assistant Program!

The first step toward your new career is attending a **mandatory** Nursing Assistant Student Orientation. You must attend an orientation **prior** to your Nursing Assistant course start date. *(Please note: If you are registered for the **Hybrid or Multi-Cultural Nursing Assistant**, these courses hold their **orientation on the first day of class**. It is not necessary for you to also attend one of the sessions shown on this sheet.)*
