| Immunizations | Immunizations are NOT required in order to complete this course. However, immunizations are generally required by employers and the State of Idaho in order to receive your EMT certification. The most common immunizations employers may require are: TB, MMR, Hepatitis B, and Tdap. Immunization requirements will vary based on future employer requirements/needs. | |
