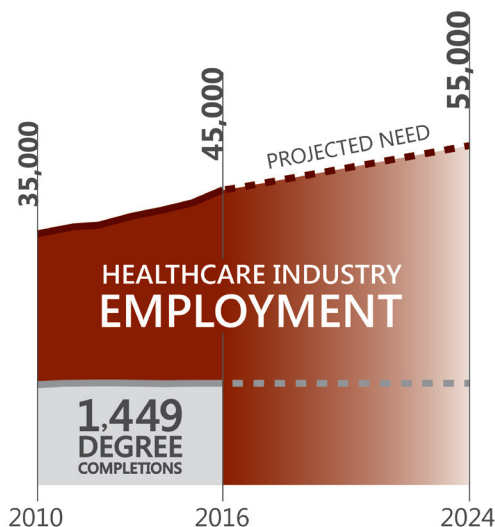
WHY A SHORTAGE?

OUR INVESTMENT

State Support

Governor C.L. "Butch" Otter recommended, and the Idaho Legislature approved, a \$10 million appropriation in 2018 for a new CWI Health Science Building from the permanent building fund. The remaining funds of \$39 million must be secured by June 2019.



Plant Facilities Levy

- A plant facilities levy for \$39 million will appear on page three of the Nov. 6 ballot.
- The levy will extend for 10 years.
