### **Summary: How to Set up the Different Kinds of Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA).**

After IT has activated MFA on your CWI account, you will be prompted to follow the attached screens to add your security verification. This could occur through multiple ways, for example: Microsoft Outlook, OneDrive, Teams, etc.

During the authentication process, you will be asked to choose future methods of authenticating. The next time you log in, you will have to authenticate using your chosen method.

#### **Please note:**

- If you are using the built-in mail application on your **Android** device, you will need to download and use the Outlook app for MFA to work on your phone. For **Apple** devices, if you are not able to connect and configure MFA, you may need to remove your email account from the native email client then re-add it and it should get MFA started. Optionally, you may also download and install the Outlook app.

If you are using the PUBLIC-WIFI connection at CWI on your phone when you initially authenticate, then change to using your cellular service, you will be prompted to enter a new code.

- **ALSO! PLEASE** Download the Microsoft Authenticator App before you start this process. You will scan the QR code from within that app.
- User your Phone's camera to scan the QR code on the next Page. Cover the one not for your phone with your hand so you don't accidentally scan the incorrect code.
- If you open this on your phone tap on the link below the QR Code.

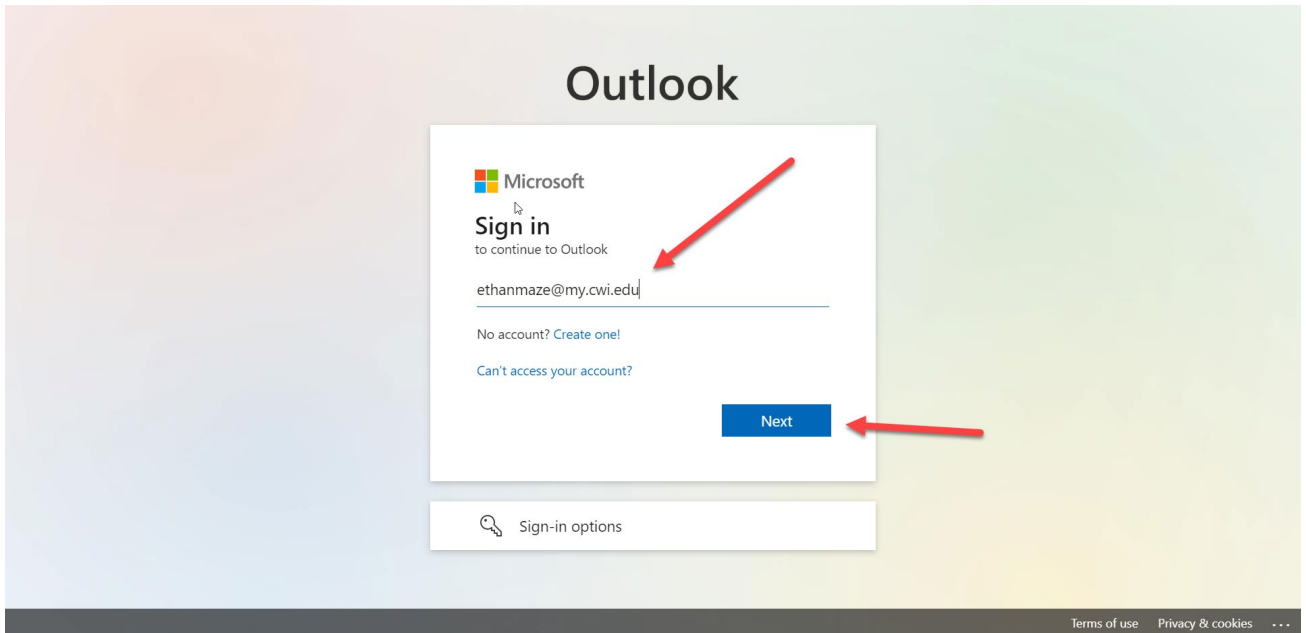

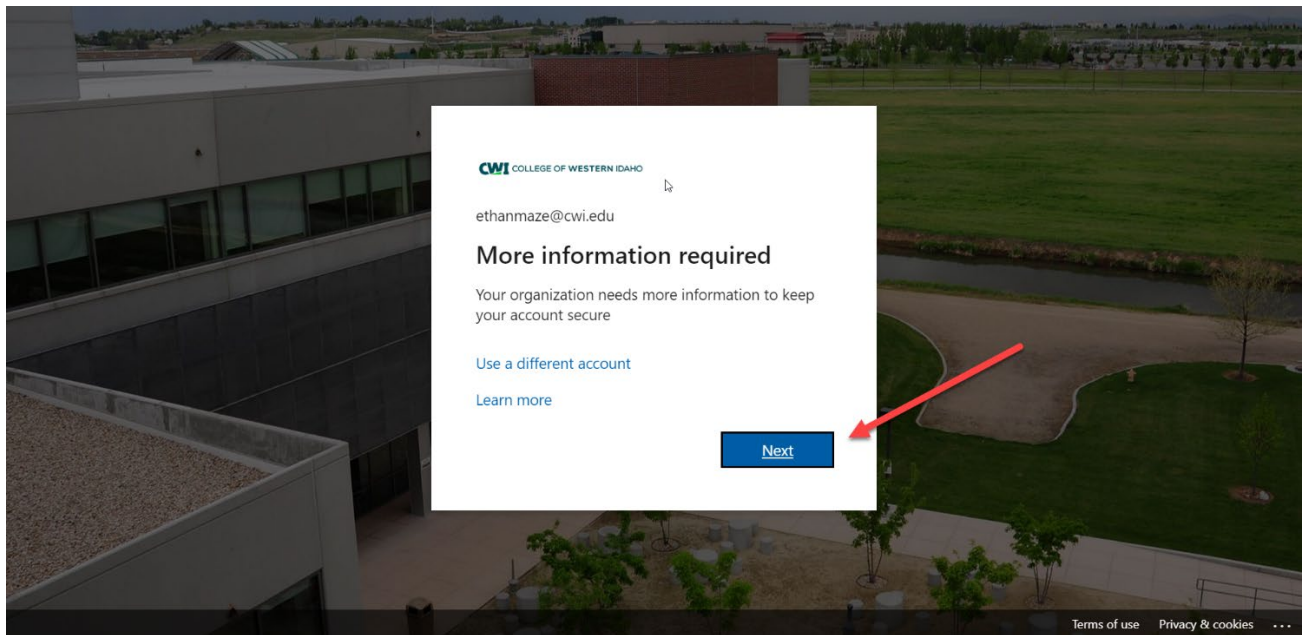

**Step 1:** Attempt to login to your outlook (or any Office 365 products) with your school account

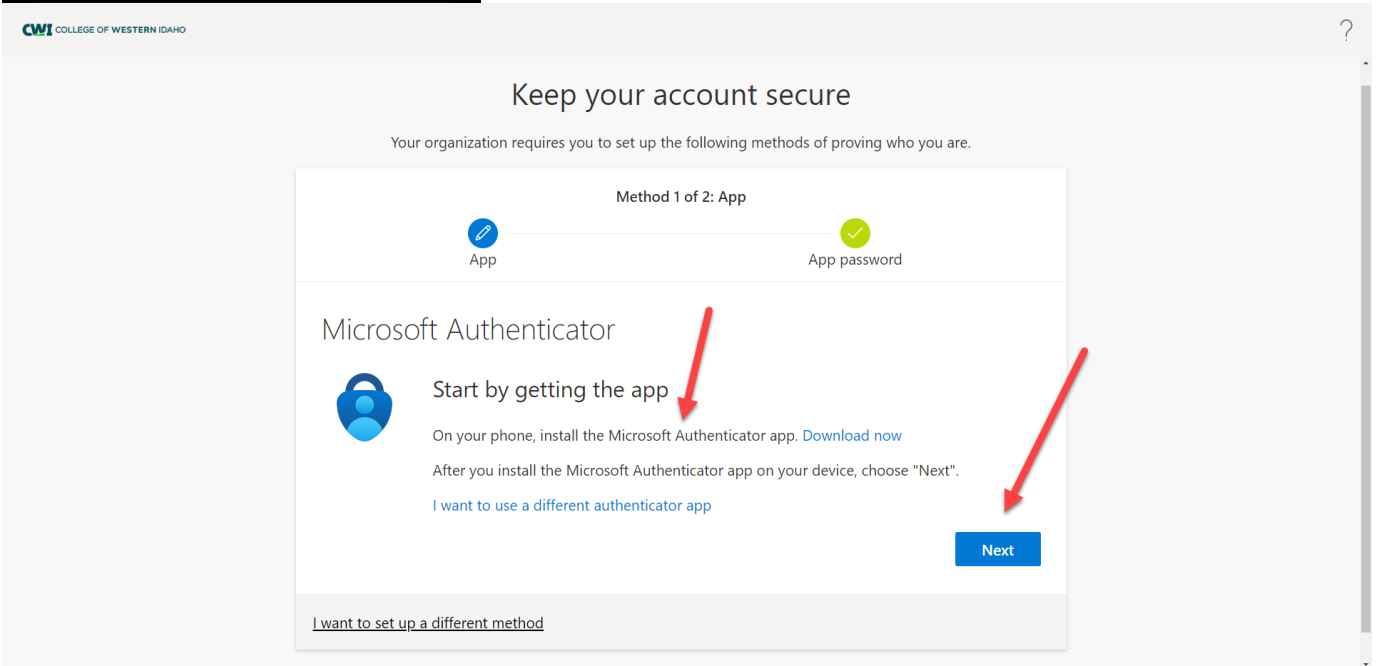
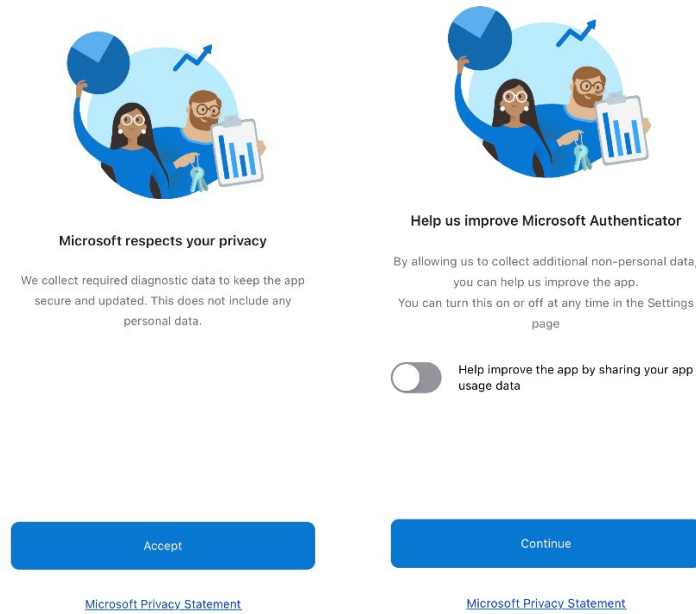
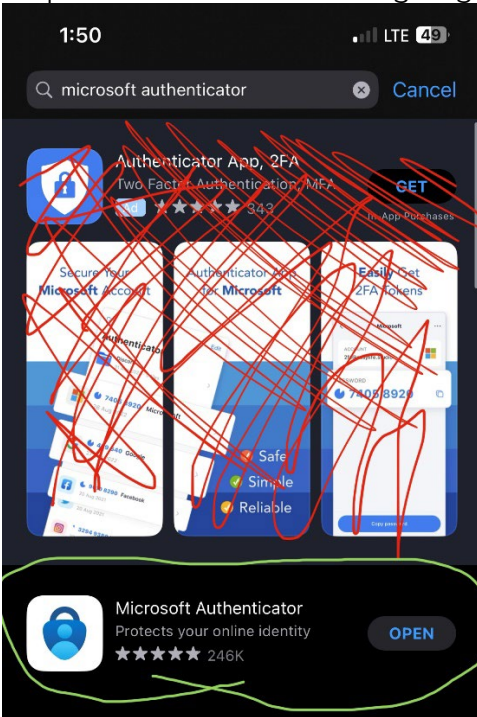
1. Enter your credentials at this point and hit the next button twice, one on this slide and one on the next

- At this point it will take you to a screen where you will need to download the Microsoft Authenticator App. While its downloading Go ahead and hit next twice following the steps on the on the screen going through the mobile app.

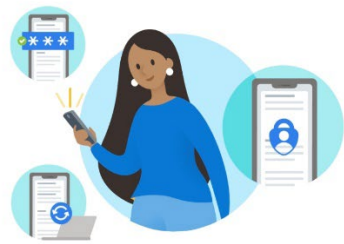
If prompted, allow notifications. Then add an account, and select "Work or school".

4. At this point if you hit next, it should be configured and as long as you have notifications enabled for the Microsoft Authenticator app on your phone. You should be able to login to any Office 365 apps via clicking accept within this app on your phone. You will now be directed to Logon using MFA





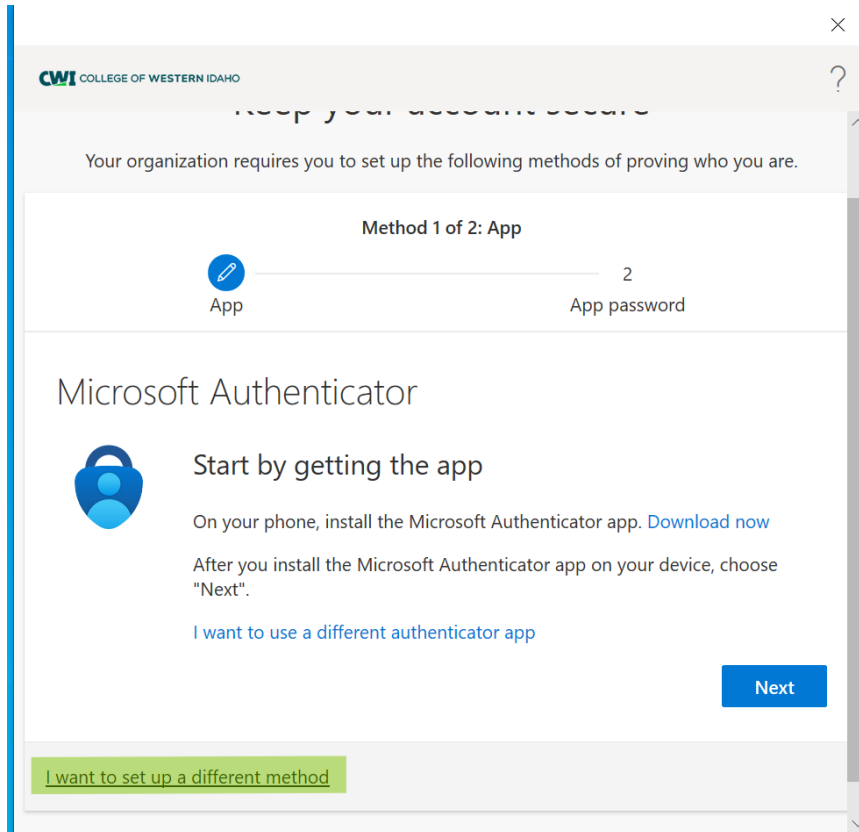
5. Next time you login it will ask if you would like to make this a trusted device for the next 60 days, this is optional.

- a. When an attempt is made to log on to a new device MFA will be required to continue.

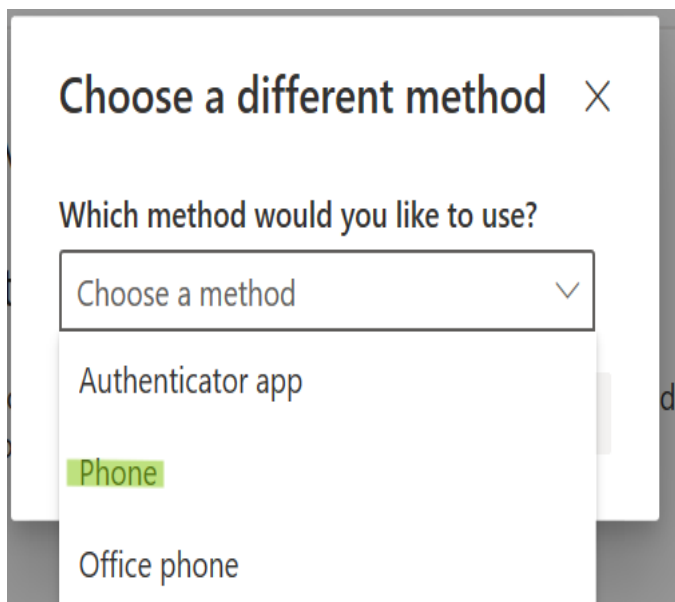


5. If you want to use the Text Method instead of the Microsoft Authenticator app:

- a. Go back to Step 2 before downloading the Microsoft Authenticator app and choose 'I want to set up a different method.'



- b. You will then be given the options between phone, office phone, or Authenticator app. Choose phone.





- c. You will now be given an option to receive a code through text or voice call.
