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STEP 6: KAPLAN NURSING ADMISSIONS EXAM

Enter the **Score** from your enclosed Kaplan Nursing Admissions Exam (must be within five years). The Kaplan Nursing Admissions Exam must be taken at the CWI Testing Center. **Benchmark for Kaplan Nursing Admissions Exam is 75%. Any score less than 75% will result in denial of application.** You will receive 10% of your total score. For example, if you scored a 75.3% on your test, move your decimal point to the left one place and enter 7.53 below for your STEP 6 score. **A student is only allowed two attempts per year between the beginning of January and the end of November.**

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STEP 7 VERIFICATION OF CURRENT AND UNINCUMBERED HEALTH CERTIFICATION

While a healthcare certification is not required to apply, it could count towards your ranking points. **Include a copy of your current certification/licensing. Expired or lapsed certifications will not be accepted. Certification must list the date issued and expiration dates.** You must use the certificate/license with the highest point value. Ex: If you have a CMA and an EMT certification, you will score a "2", not a "3". However, a CNA and EMT can be combined for two points.

- Fall 2024 Cohort Applicants will be notified via their CWI Email of the status of their application after June 4, 2024.
- Spring 2025 Cohort Applicants will be notified via their CWI Email of the status of their application after November 15, 2024.
- If submitting new application information as outlined above, you will ONLY submit NEW material for points to be added to your current application.
- If not accepted to either Fall or Spring, you will need to submit a whole new application for the following year.
- If you are put on the alternate list, but not admitted you will be readded to the spring 25 application pool. As a re-added student you may be accepted, denied, or put back on the alternate list.
